

Junior Belfast Giants Ice Hockey Club Code of Conduct for Players



When I register as a player, I am signing to agree my membership of the Junior Belfast Giants Ice Hockey Club, and also to confirm that I understand and will, to the best of my ability, adhere to this Code of Conduct:

- I will participate because I want to and for the fun of it, not because my Parents or Coach want me to
- I will co-operate with and respect my Coach, officials, team mates and opponents, because without them, there would not be a game for me to take part in
- I will be on the ice in full kit – on time for training
- I will play to the rules of the game
- I will pay full attention to the Coaches instructions
- I will accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally
- I will obey the whistle
- I will resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques
- I will always try to control my temper – both my team, and I will benefit - I understand that competition is stressful and can provoke powerful emotions but fighting and “mouthing off” spoils the game for everyone
- I will not use inappropriate language
- I will be a team player and encourage others to work together - if I work hard my team will benefit
- I will set a positive example for others, particularly younger players and supporters
- I will wait for permission to get on the ice
- I will remember that my Coaches and Officials are there to help me - I understand, that whilst they can and will make mistakes from time to time, I must still respect their decisions
- I will let my coach and Captain ask any necessary questions to officials
- I will give my full commitment to the training programmes
- I will remember that whilst it is great to win, it should be fun to play - at all times
- I will thank my Coach, the Officials and my parents/supporters for their time and support
- I will respect the facilities and the property of others
- I will behave appropriately and be respectful to others when travelling to games and representing The Junior Belfast Giants
- I will not purchase, or consume alcohol, tobacco products, solvents, illegal drugs of any kind, or be in the possession of a dangerous article whilst representing The Club or Club Members
- I will not part participate in Club activities whilst under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances
- I will behave appropriately in the changing room & arena when attending club training, and representing The Club at games

Code of Conduct for Players



I, a team member with the Junior Belfast Giants, agree to the following Code of Conduct whilst travelling to and from a venue with my team:

- To behave in an appropriate manner while representing The Club travelling to and from games
- Respect my Coach, Team Managers, Club Officials and my Team Players
- I will respect other Clubs Official and their property
- I will refrain from using inappropriate language at all times

When travelling to participate in away matches, I agree to travel to such matches only under Club arrangements and using Club transport unless otherwise agreed in advance with the permission of the Club Committee.

Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct while travelling via Coach/Boat to and from a venue representing our Club will result in disciplinary action and as result you may be suspended from playing with your Team.

Ice Hockey is a fast and often aggressive sport but there is a big difference between playing and training competitively, and the intimidation and abuse of others. Junior Belfast Giants Ice Hockey Club has a policy of ZERO TOLERANCE towards verbal and physical abuse. Any individual found to be involved in the verbal or physical abuse of another club member may, at the discretion of the Disciplinary Committee, be suspended from the Club.
